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# Information research and gathering for your paper

When your task is to write a paper, finding more information on your research topic is essential. You will need different kinds of information at the various stages of your research process. According to Rumsey (2004: 2), the process of "finding, accessing and handling information" can be "more circular than linear for large projects". To a certain extent this is true of all research. Research into a topic will usually uncover unthought-of aspects of the original question or raise new questions, which will lead to the need for additional, different or new information and a new round of information research and gathering.

Rumsey (2004: 2) names the following stages of the "information-gathering process":

- Analysing the question or problem
- Defining the scope of the research and what information is required
- Identifying sources of that information (resource discovery)
- Finding where the information is stored (resource location)
- Gaining access to the information
- Ensuring that the information retrieved is a) what is required b) reliable (and possibly c) current)
- Managing searches and results
- Keeping up to date and monitoring new developments

## **(1) Defining your research topic and deciding on what information is needed**

**Ask yourself:** *What is or how do I define my topic question? What aim and scope does my research project have? What type(s) of research does my project involve? What background information do I need to formulate my research question? What are the questions my research should answer? What is my "main" research question? Which information resources are relevant to what I wish to achieve? What kind of information do I need when?*



**Try to formulate answers to these questions for your own research:**

*Research question:*

*Aim and scope of research*

*Type of research:*

*What questions should my research answer?*

*What are my own ideas at this stage?*

*What information do I need next?*

## (2) Developing information research strategies

**Q: What information resources will allow me to find the information I need?**

**A1: To find out basic or general information about a subject**

→ consult

- subject dictionaries or encyclopaedias (online or in the Library)
- subject handbooks, introductions or other surveys (online or in the Library)



- **ABELL (Annual Bibliography of English Language and Literature; auch via LION=Literature Online)**  
"ABELL wird herausgegeben von der MHRA (Modern Humanities Research Association) und beinhaltet bibliographische Zitate von Monographien, Zeitschriftenartikeln, kommentierten Ausgaben von literarischen Werken, Buchbesprechungen, Aufsatzsammlungen und Dissertationen aus der ganzen Welt. Die Abdeckung gerade des Zeitraums zwischen 1920 und 1955 ist bis dato unerreicht.

The ERIC (Educational Resources Information Center) database consists of two files: the Resources in Education (RIE) file of document citations and the Current Index to Journals in Education (CIJE) file of journal article citations from over 750 professional journals. In addition, ERIC now contains over 850 ERIC Digest records that feature the full text of the original document.
- **Humanities International Complete**

- **MLA (Modern Language Association (MLA) International Bibliography)**  
"access to more than 1.5 million bibliographic citations to journal articles, books, and dissertations from 1963 to the present in academic disciplines such as: language, literature, folklore, linguistics, literary theory and criticism, and the dramatic arts"; from 1926.
- **Online Contents Linguistik**

- **Year's Work in Critical and Cultural Theory, The (YWCCT)** (also via **LION** = Literature Online)  
The Year's Work in Critical & Cultural Theory is a companion volume to YWES. It provides a narrative bibliography of work in the field of critical and cultural theory, recording significant debates and issues of interest in a broad field of research in the humanities and social sciences. As the field of critical and cultural studies expands, so the range and scope of the volume grow, and volumes now include chapters on Queer theories and cultures and Film Studies. Future volumes will continue this development, particularly in the field of cultural theory and new areas developing in the USA and Australia.
- **Year's Work in English Studies, The (YWES)**  
The Year's Work in English Studies is the qualitative narrative bibliographical review of scholarly work on English language and literatures written in English. Each volume includes a detailed overview from Old English to contemporary critical works for a given year, and contains critical notices for some 1100 books; extensive coverage of English Language, American Literature, New Literatures in English and English Literature; coverage of specialist periodicals; comprehensive indexing by critic, author, and subject; plus bibliographical endnotes for each chapter.
