Content Notice against racism and discrimination

This “Content Notice” is an indication that this book contains racist or discriminatory content.

It is intended to draw attention to the fact that this work must be read critically. The content of the work is to be understood as a product of its time. The fact that it is part of the Vienna University Library’s holdings is due to our collections having grown historically. For an academic library, keeping such works accessible is important because by engaging with them, we can better understand and reflect upon history and learn from it.

The Vienna University Library requests that the present work be regarded in its historical context, and at the same time expressly distances itself from all discriminatory, racist and colonialist content!

What to do if you discover racist content in our holdings?

Take action and put discrimination on notice!

1. Pick up a “Content Notice” at the information desk
2. Put it inside the book and make it visible to other users
3. Read with critical attention
