Library and research skills

✓ Library basics

This session provides an overview of our library. It also introduces some basic reading and research strategies.

Duration: 45 minutes

✓ Literature research: fundamentals and strategies

An introduction to various methods of searching for academic literature, including how to use u:search, the Electronic Journals Library, and subject-specific psychology databases such as PSYINDEX and PsycInfo.

Duration: 90 minutes

✓ Evaluating academic information

This session addresses different types of academic sources and the criteria by which their quality can be assessed.

Duration: 90 minutes

✓ Fake science – best practices to avoid questionable publications

This tutorial offers an introduction to the topic of fake science and provides an overview of tools and strategies for identifying questionable publication practices and journals. Additionally, it presents goals and aspects of the Open Science movement as a response to non-transparent publishing.

Citation skills (APA Style)

✓ Citation according to APA: 1 – basics

An introduction to the citation style outlined in the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA). Through practical exercises, you will learn how to correctly cite books, articles, etc. in line with the 7th edition of the APA guidelines.

Duration: 1 hour

✓ Citation according to APA: 2 – special cases

An advanced session focusing on special cases (e.g. audiovisual media, translated works) and how to cite them in line with the 7th edition of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA).

Duration: 1 hour

Reference management skills

✓ Reference management software: Zotero

Introduction to the benefits and applications of reference management programs, using Zotero as an example.

Duration: 1 hour

Digital & AI literacy for academia

✓ AI competency: fundamentals

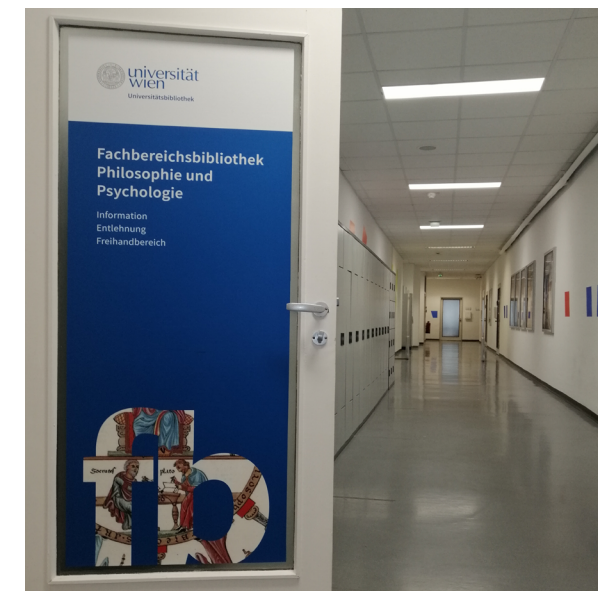
Introduction to general guidelines for the use of artificial intelligence and the University of Vienna's policies as an information ethics framework for AI use in academic studies. The responsible use of AI in academic work is jointly reflected upon.

Duration: 45 minutes

✓ AI tools: hands-on application in literature research

Selected AI tools and their background are introduced and applied in practice. Guidance is provided on the responsible use of AI tools.
