Planning



The University Library supports researchers in planning their research projects.

u:cris, the research information system, records funding applications throughout the application process and at the time of approval.

The **development of data management plans (DMP)** is part of research planning and clarifies data handling.

Metadata Support

Metadata are more than information about other data. Vienna University Library provides researchers with advice concerning the formats and contents suitable for storing research data.

OpenAIRE

renders assistance in preparing data management plans, in considering publication costs when planning the budget and in issuing relevant guidelines for EU-funded projects.

Utilization



Visibility and impact are two key elements in the utilization of research findings.

The **bibliometric services for researchers of the University of Vienna** offer basic training as well as individual advice on optimising publication strategies and increasing visibility based on individual bibliometric profiles.

u:cris is the University of Vienna's research information system. It contains publications, presentations, third-party-funded research projects and many other activities of the University's researchers.

Advice on publishing EU-funded projects is provided by the OpenAIRE National Open Access Desk.

DOI and **ORCID** are important digital identifiers researchers can assign.

The **Open Access Office** offers a wide range of services:

- The Open Access Office grants **funding for open access publications**.
- **u:scholar** enables the open access publication of academic publications.
- **Open Journal Systems (OJS)** allows Open Access journals to be published at Vienna University.
- Information concerning **legal issues of Open-Access-publishing** is available from the Open Access Office.

Research data



The long-term storage of research data is made possible via digital infrastructure for the processing and storage of data.

- **Phaidra** is the system for managing and archiving research data.
- **AUSSDA – The Austrian Social Science Data Archive** provides a national research infrastructure for social sciences data.
